
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Ways and Means to Original House Bill No. 207 by Representative Harris

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S." and before the comma "," delete "47:305(D)(1)(n)" and insert
3 "47:305(D)(3)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete line 3 in its entirety, and on line 4, delete "products eligible for the
6 exemption;" and insert "for an exemption for bakery products;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 7, after "R.S." and before "is" delete "47:305(D)(1)(n)" and insert
9 "47:305(D)(3)"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, delete lines 10 through 20 in their entirety, and insert the following:

12 "D.

13 * * *

14 (3) ~~Food~~ (a) Except as provided in Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph,
15 food sales by restaurants, drive-ins, snack bars, candy and nut counters, private
16 clubs, and sales made by an establishment not specifically exempted elsewhere who
17 furnish facilities for the consumption of the food on the premises are not exempt
18 from the taxes imposed by taxing authorities.

19 (b) Bakery products sold at grocery stores, bakeries, and donut shops which
20 furnish facilities for the consumption of food on the premises shall be exempt from
21 state sales and use taxes."

22 AMENDMENT NO. 5

23 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 5 in their entirety and insert the following:

24 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015; if vetoed by the
25 governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
26 effective on July 1, 2015, or on the day following such approval by the legislature,
27 whichever is later."
