2 On page 1, line 2, after "To" insert "amend and reenact R.S. 32:402.1(D) and to" and after
3 "32:410(D)" and before "and" insert ", 412(D)(3)(f) and (4)(d),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 3, after "cards;" insert "to provide for participation in driver training
6 programs;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 4, after "license;" and before "and" insert "to provide for driver's license
9 renewal for individuals with a disability;"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 6, after "Section 1." insert "R.S. 32:402.1(D) is hereby amended and
12 reenacted and" and after "R.S. 32:410(D)" delete "is" and insert "and 412(D)(3)(f) and (4)(d)
13 are"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 1, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:

16 "§402.1. Driver education; required
17 * * *
18 D. No person under the age of fifteen shall be allowed to enroll or
19 participate in the driving experience portion of any driver education course
20 or driver training program. A person, no sooner than ninety days prior to his
21 fifteenth birthday and who is in, at a minimum, grade ~~nine~~ eight, shall be
22 permitted to participate in the classroom instruction component of a driver
23 education course or driving program.

26 On page 2, between lines 2 and 3, insert the following:

28 §412. Amount of fees; credit or refund; duration of license; veteran
29 designation; university logo; "I'm a Cajun" designation; disbursement
30 of funds; renewal by mail or electronic commerce of Class "D" or
31 "E" drivers' licenses; disposition of certain fees; exception

35 (3) A Class "D" or "E" operator's license may be
36 renewed by mail or electronic commerce, except as follows:

38 (f) Notwithstanding Subparagraphs (a) and (b) of this
39 Paragraph, a renewal by mail may be granted to a person
40 seventy years of age or older who is medically diagnosed

with a disability that precludes that person from renewing their license in person.

(4) The renewal by mail or electronic commerce shall include the following:

(d) A sworn affidavit by a physician certifying that the person seventy years of age or older possesses all cognitive functions reasonably necessary to be a prudent driver.
