Creates a special subcommittee to study certain matters relative to registrars of voters

Proposed House Resolution (proposed resolution) creates a subcommittee to study Registrars of Voters offices statewide and gives the subcommittee the authority to hold meetings. The subcommittee will consist of three members of the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs and four members of the House Committee on Appropriations. Proposed resolution requires the cooperation of all state agencies, departments, and staffs in carrying out the subcommittee's mission. The subcommittee must file a report of its findings and recommendations no later than 30 days prior to the 2016 Regular Legislative Session. The subcommittee will be dissolved upon adjournment of the 2016 Regular Legislative Session.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION


The proposed resolution may result in an increase in state general fund expenditures. This bill creates a subcommittee to study Registrars of Voters offices statewide. To the extent this bill results in additional legislative subcommittee hearings, members will be eligible for legislative per diem of \$150 plus the mileage reimbursement, which is currently \$0.58/mile. However, such costs could be reduced if subcommittee meetings coincide with another scheduled committee meeting, such as the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. This bill may also result in an indeterminable increase in expenditures to the extent additional materials are needed to complete the study on Registrars of Voters.

This proposed resolution dissolves upon adjournment of the 2016 Regular Legislative Session.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
