HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 121

A RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, public safety services, to conduct a study relative to the production of a combination mobility impaired specialty prestige license plate.

WHEREAS, state law provides for owners of motor vehicles to show support for a particular organization or philanthropic interest by purchasing a special prestige license plate; and

WHEREAS, state law provides for any person with a permanent mobility impairment to purchase a special license plate indicating a mobility impairment; and

WHEREAS, state law does not provide for any person with a permanent mobility impairment to show support for any particular organization or philanthropic interest by purchasing a combination mobility impaired special license plate and a speciality prestige license plate; and

WHEREAS, state law should provide for the purchase of a combination mobility impaired speciality prestige license plate.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, public safety services, to conduct a study relative to the production of a combination mobility impaired specialty prestige license plate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department shall prepare and submit a final report that contains the results of the study requested by this Resolution and submit such final report to the House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works and the Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works no later than February 1, 2016.
