MTR VEHICLE/LICEN PLATES: Creates the "Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal" specialty license plate

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Make technical changes.
2. Clarify provisions that create the "Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal" license plate and specify that upon application of a person showing reasonable proof that he is a recipient of such medal the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections will issue that recipient a military honor license plate.
3. Delete language relative to the fee for a standard motor vehicle license plate.
4. Add a mandate specifying that the license plate fee for a standard motor vehicle is equal to the license tax imposed by the Constitution of Louisiana and the handling fee is fixed at \$3.50 per plate.
5. Clarify that a surviving spouse of a person with a military honor license plate may retain the license plate if they are not remarried and apply to the secretary of state for a transfer of the plate.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law creates the "Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal" license plate for recipients of the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal and provides for the use, name, fee, design, and specifications of the specialty plate.

Proposed law requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to develop and adopt rules relative to the implementation of the specialty plate including the transfer of the license plate to the surviving spouse and the disposition of the specialty plate.
