AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 18:1461(B), relative to election offenses; to provide relative to the criminal penalties for certain election offenses; to provide for the criminal penalties for bribery of voters; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 18:1461(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1461. Bribery of voters; penalties

* * *

B. Whoever violates any provision of this Section shall be fined not more than ~~two~~ four thousand dollars or be imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for not more than two years, or both, for the first offense. On a second offense, or any subsequent offense, the penalty shall be a fine of not more than ~~five~~ ten thousand dollars or imprisonment at hard labor for not more than five years, or both.
