CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

Keyword and oneliner of the instrument as it left the House

ENVIRONMENT/LITTERING: Provides with respect to fines for the offense of littering

Report rejects Senate amendments which would have:

1. Changed the proposed fine increase for second offense intentional littering from \$1,000 to not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.
2. Changed the proposed fine increase for third and subsequent offense intentional littering from \$2,500 to not less than \$1,500 nor more than \$2,500.
3. Changed the proposed civil fine increase for second and subsequent offense simple littering from \$1,000 to not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.
4. Changed the distribution of money collected for litter violations by decreasing the percentage to the sheriff, parish governing authority, or municipality in which the violation occurred if they have established a litter abatement work program from 15% to 10%.
5. Distributed 5% of the money collected for litter violations to the office of the public defender of the judicial district where the violation occurred.

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

The bill as proposed by the conference committee is the same as the bill finally passed by the House.
