7	authority of political subdivisions; to provide relative to Millennium Trust and				
8	certain offshore revenues investment; and to provide for related matters.

16	revenues which are deposited into any fund created pursuant to the constitution or				
17	statutes of the state which are determined by the state treasurer to be available for

25	any general fund or special fund of the political subdivision, and any other funds

27	determine to be available for investment in any of the following obligations:

B. Funds on deposit in state treasury.

(1) The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to invest monies on deposit in the state treasury belonging to the general fund of the state, funds in the state treasury to the credit of state agencies, departments, boards, and commissions, and any other funds under the control of the state treasurer which he, in his discretion, may determine to be available for investment in the following:

- (e)(i) Investment grade commercial paper and investment grade corporate notes and bonds traded in United States markets, denominated in United States dollars, and issued in the United States by a corporation whose common stock is listed on the New York Stock Exchange, the American Stock Exchange, the National Association of Securities Dealers Automated Quotations Systems, or other such stock exchange domiciled in the United States and registered with the United States Securities and Exchange Commission. However, at no time shall the funds invested in paper, notes, and bonds enumerated in this Subparagraph exceed twenty percent of all monies invested as of that date Investment grade commercial paper issued in the United States, traded in the United States markets, denominated in United States dollars, with a short-term rating of at least A-1 by Standard & Poor's Financial Services LLC or P-1 by Moody's Investor Service, Inc. or the equivalent rating by a Nationally Recognized Statistical Rating Organization (NRSRO).
- (ii) Investment grade corporate notes and bonds issued in the United States, traded in United States markets, denominated in United States dollars, rated Baa or better by Moody's Investor Service, Inc. or BBB or better by Standard & Poor's Financial Services LLC, and the trades of which are settled through The Depository Trust & Clearing Corporation (DTCC), a national clearinghouse in the United States for the settlement of securities trades.
  - (iii) However, at no time shall the funds invested in paper, notes, and

bonds enumerated in these Items exceed twenty percent of all monies invested
as of that date.
