Abstract: Makes it illegal to sell or purchase a firearm without waiting for a 10-day period between purchase and delivery of the firearm.

Proposed law creates a crime of illegally purchasing or selling a firearm which is the selling of a firearm by a licensed firearms dealer or accepting delivery of a firearm from a licensed firearms dealer without waiting a mandatory 10-day period from purchase to delivery of the firearm.

Proposed law creates exceptions to the 10-day waiting period for law enforcement officers and concealed handgun permit holders.

Proposed law provides penalties of a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000 or imprisonment for not less than one year nor more than five years, or both.
