2 To enact R.S. 44:33.1, relative to public records; to require public bodies to make certain 3 information concerning the custodian of records publicly available; to provide for the 4 manner in which such information is required to be made publicly available; and to 5 provide for related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 44:33.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 8 §33.1. Custodian; contact information 9 Each public body that has a custodian of public records shall make the 10 identity and contact information of the custodian available to the public in a manner 11 that will allow a member of the public to quickly determine the appropriate person 12 to whom a public records request should be submitted, including by placing such 13 information on the internet.

Abstract: Requires each public body that has a custodian of public records to make the identity and contact information of the custodian available to the public.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 44:1 et seq.—Public Records Law) provides for access and retention of public records. Establishes a framework for the ready availability of public records to requesting persons, and specifically provides that it is the duty of the custodian of the public records for a public entity or agency to provide copies to persons so requesting.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally requires each public body that has a custodian of public records to make the identity and contact information of the custodian available to the public in a manner that will allow a member of the public to quickly determine the appropriate person to whom a public records request should be submitted, including by placing such information on the internet.
