

1 Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
2 to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 8,
3 2016.

4 Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election,
5 there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
6 to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as
7 follows:

8 Do you support an amendment to exempt from state sales and use tax

Abstract: Adds an exemption for alternative energy sold directly to the consumer for residential use.

Present constitution exempts from state sales and use tax natural gas, electricity, and water sold directly to the consumer for residential use.

Proposed constitutional amendment retains present constitution and adds an exemption for alternative energy sold directly to the consumer for residential use.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 8, 2016.
