CONTRACTS. Directs the commissioner of administration, the commissioner of higher education, and statewide elected officials to review certain state contracts to identify any that can be terminated and report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget by March 17, 2016.

Directs the commissioner of administration, the commissioner of higher education, the lieutenant governor, the secretary of state, the attorney general, the treasurer, the commissioner of agriculture, the public service commission, and the commissioner of insurance to review all state contracts and identify any contracts currently in effect that can be terminated according to the terms of the contract, determine the amount of savings as a result of terminating the contract, take such action as is necessary to initiate the termination, excluding contracts for critical healthcare services and contracts for classroom activities related to elementary and secondary education. Requires an initial report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget on or before March 17, 2016.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to the original bill:

1. Require boards and commissions to provide the information requested by the Resolution.
2. Change date of report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget from March 1, 2016, to an initial report by March 1, 2016, and a report of all findings by March 14, 2016.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Require that the report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget identify contracts that are awarded to minority and women owned businesses.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to the reengrossed bill

1. Changed date of report from an initial report by March 1, 2016, and a report of all findings by March 14, 2016, to an initial report on or before March 17, 2016.
