AN ACT

To enact R.S. 32:144(C), relative to parking; to provide for parking in a residence district;  
and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 32:144(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§144. Additional parking regulations

\* \* \*

**C. The provisions of Subsection A of this Section shall not apply to any vehicle standing or parked on a highway or street in a residence district as defined in R.S. 32:1(56).**

Present law requires every vehicle standing or parked on a highway where there are adjacent curbs to stand or park with the right-hand wheels of such vehicle parallel to and within eighteen inches of the right-hand curb.

Present law defines "residence district" as the territory contiguous to a highway not comprising a business district, when the frontage on such a highway for a distance of three hundred feet or more is mainly occupied by dwellings or by dwellings and buildings in use

for business.

Proposed law provides that present law does not apply in a residence district.

Effective August 1, 2016.
