AN ACT

To enact R.S. 33:9682, relative to political subdivisions; to authorize a political subdivision to open proceedings with a voluntary prayer; to provide certain terms and conditions; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:9682 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§9682. Political subdivisions; voluntary prayer

A. A political subdivision may open proceedings with a voluntary prayer.

However, no official or standard prayer shall be used or adopted.

B. This Section is intended to reflect the tradition and practice of ceremonial invocations that are meant to lend gravity to a public occasion. The implementation of this Section shall be neutral toward religion, and shall not be intended nor interpreted as state support of or interference with religion or promoted as a religious exercise.
