Donahue

Present law provides for the duties of the legislative auditor and provides that he shall conduct performance audits to evaluate the effectiveness and operation of programs and activities.

Proposed law retains present law and further requires the legislative auditor to conduct a performance audit on each statutory dedication that includes a fee for service at least once every four years to determine if the fees are adequate to cover the costs associated with the service.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
