**Abstract:** Adds information that shall be included in a judgment of interdiction

Present law provides for procedures for the interdiction of certain persons. Provides certain requirements for the judgement of interdiction, but present law does not require the judgment to contain personal information of the defendant.

Proposed law requires judgments of interdiction to include the defendant's name, domicile, age, current address, and address following the interdiction hearing.
