Abstract: Allows prescription drugs that were dispensed to persons in custody of a local law enforcement agency to be returned, exchanged, and redispensed.

<u>Present law</u> requires that drugs dispensed for use by an offender in the custody of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections be accepted for return, exchange, and redispensing.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the pharmacist in charge shall determine that the prescription is unmolested, unexpired, and fit to be redispensed.

<u>Present law</u> releases the pharmaceutical manufacturer from liability for any claim or injury arising from the redispensing of any prescription drug.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and extends it to include prescriptions dispensed for use by offenders in the custody of local law enforcement offices or departments.
