Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to Original Senate Bill No. 9 by Senator Donahue

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 7, between “monies;” and “and” insert the following:

3 "to provide for the transfer, dedication, use, and appropriation as specified of certain treasury
4 funds; to authorize the transfer of balances to the state general fund; to provide for an
5 effective date;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, line 13, change "**deficits,**" to "**deficits for the prior fiscal year,**"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 2, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following:

10 "Section 2. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, the state
11 treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the following amounts into the State
12 General Fund (Direct) from the funds specified below in accordance with the reductions
13 enacted in the bill that originated as HB 122 of the 2016 First Extraordinary Session of the
14 Legislature:

5 Section 3. Within ten days after the effective date of this Act, the state treasurer shall
6 make all transfers provided in this Act. In the event that the amount of any reduction in
7 State General Fund by Fees and Self-generated Revenues, Statutory Dedications, or
8 Interagency Transfers being transferred to the State General Fund (Direct) are insufficient
9 to fully fund the reduction made from such fund source on the tenth day following the
10 effective date of this Act or on that date the amount remaining in Fees and Self-generated
11 Revenues, Statutory Dedications, or Interagency Transfers is insufficient to fully fund the
12 reductions required by this Act and the appropriations remaining after the reductions in this
13 Act, the treasurer shall notify the commissioner of administration and the Joint Legislative
14 Committee on the Budget."
