AN ACT
To amend and reenact R.S. 42:17(A)(10), relative to exceptions to open meetings; to provide
for attorney-client privilege; and to provide for related matters.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 42:17(A)(10) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
§17. Exceptions to open meetings
A. A public body may hold an executive session pursuant to R.S. 42:16 for one or
more of the following reasons:
* * *
(10) Or Discussion of matters subject to attorney-client privilege, or any other
matters now provided for or as may be provided for by the legislature.
* * *
