Ward

<u>Present law</u>, relative to the Louisiana Energy and Power Authority, provides for a director to be a citizen of the United States and domiciled in the state of Louisiana and the municipality represented. <u>Present law</u> further provides for a director representing a municipality which, together with the parish in which it is located is governed by a parish-council consolidated form of government, need not be domiciled in the municipality, but must be domiciled within the parish in which the municipality is located.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>, but regarding a director from a municipality with a parish-council consolidated form of government, adds that a director may also qualify by being an employee of the municipality he represents.

Effective August 1, 2016.
