HOUSE BILL NO. 869

VOTERS/VOTING: Authorizes use of state issued hang tags for those who suffer from mobility impairment for purpose of special voting accommodations

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 18:564(D)(2)(a)(iv) and 1309.3(D)(1)(a)(iv), relative to voting; to provide for  
3 eligibility for receiving assistance in voting on election day and during early voting;  
4 to provide procedures and requirements for receiving assistance in voting; and to  
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 18:564(D)(2)(a)(iv) and 1309.3(D)(1)(a)(iv) are hereby enacted to  
8 read as follows:

9 §564. Assistance in voting on election day

13 (2)(a) A voter shall also be entitled to assistance without having filed with  
14 the registrar a statement setting forth the necessity and reasons for this assistance if,  
15 on election day, the voter presents to the commissioner-in-charge one of the  
16 following as proof of disability:

18 (iv) A current mobility impairment hang tag or license plate issued to the  
19 voter by the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections pursuant  
20 to R.S. 47:463.4 or 490.4.
