<u>Present law</u> requires an owner or operator of a motor vehicle on a Louisiana public highway to have contained within the vehicle a document that evidences that the motor vehicle is in compliance with R.S. 32:361 relative to compulsory motor vehicle liability security. (R.S. 32:863.1)

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but prohibits any parish or municipal governing authority from assessing a penalty and fee in excess of \$75 for failure of an owner or operator of a motor vehicle to have contained within the vehicle a document that evidences that the motor vehicle complies with <u>present law</u>, provided that the owner has current motor vehicle liability security covering the vehicle at the time of the traffic stop.
