DIGEST 2016 Regular Session

Claitor

<u>Present law</u> provides for academic requirements for the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) awards. Provides for a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) and ACT score for each award type.

Proposed law retains present law.

SB 329 Original

<u>Present law</u> provides that for an Opportunity Award a minimum GPA of 2.50 is required. Provides that for a Performance Award and Honors Award a minimum GPA of 3.00 is required.

Proposed law retains present law for any student who graduates prior to the 2020-2021 school year.

For a student who graduates in the 2020-2021 school year or later, <u>proposed law</u> requires a minimum GPA of 2.75 for an Opportunity Award, 3.25 for a Performance Award, and 3.50 for an Honors Award.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
