HONORARY DESIGNATIONS: Designates the town of Welsh as the Home of the Cajun Dictionary

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To designate the town of Welsh as the Home of the Cajun Dictionary.

3 WHEREAS, for over twenty years, Monsignor Jules O. Daigle served as pastor of
4 Our Lady of Seven Dolors Church with great passion and devotion; and

5 WHEREAS, Father Daigle was an idol for the Cajuns, and he worked to preserve
6 their faith and the Cajun French language; and

7 WHEREAS, in 1984, after his retirement from the priesthood, he published a
8 Dictionary of the Cajun Language, which was the first dictionary devoted to Cajun French;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, Father Daigle's Dictionary of the Cajun Language will forever be an
11 integral part of the town of Welsh.

12 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
13 designate the town of Welsh as the Home of the Cajun Dictionary.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to
15 Carolyn Louviere, mayor of the town of Welsh.
