INSURERS OR NO IMPACT See Note
Provides relative to motor vehicle rental insurers. (8/1/16)

Present law permits the commissioner to issue to a rental company, whether foreign or domestic, a limited license authorizing the limited licensee and its employees to offer or sell insurance in connection with the rental of vehicles. Proposed law retains present law and adds authorized agents to those who may offer or sell insurance in connection with the rental of vehicles.

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.

The motor vehicle rental insurer fee charged by the Department of Insurance (DOI) to rental companies is based on the number of available rental vehicles the rental company insures in accordance with RS 22:821. This proposed law adds "authorized agents" to the motor vehicle rental insurers limited license; therefore, there is no anticipated self-generated revenue impact to the DOI.

Additionally, the department does not foresee an increase in the number of companies that would seek to issue rental insurance as a result of the proposed law.
