Creates the crime of wrongful exclusion of concealed handgun permit holders

Prohibits state agencies and political subdivisions from excluding concealed handgun permit holders on their premises. Present law provides for the issuance of concealed handgun permits. Present law provides for locations where concealed handgun permit holders are prohibited from carrying concealed handguns. Proposed law retains present law, but prohibits the state or its political subdivisions from excluding the carrying of concealed handguns by concealed handgun permit holders unless those locations are excluded under present law. Proposed law provides penalties of a fine of \$250 for a first violation and \$1,000 for a second or subsequent violation. Proposed law also authorizes a person adversely affected by the actions of a state agency or political subdivision to seek declarative and injunctive relief and actual and consequential damages attributable to the violation.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

To the extent that a state agency or political subdivision may exclude the carrying of a concealed handgun by a concealed handgun permit holder unless the location is excluded under present law, the proposed legislation may result in an indeterminable increase in state or political subdivision expenditures.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation may result in an indeterminable increase of local funds revenue as a result of potential fines when a state agency or a political subdivision is found to have wrongfully excluded concealed handgun permits holders in certain instances. The first violation is a maximum fine of \$250. A second or subsequent violation is fined a maximum of \$1,000.
