Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 812 by Representative Schroder

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the end of line 2, insert "or leased"

AMENDMENT NO. 2On page 1, line 11, after "owned" insert "or leased"AMENDMENT NO. 3On page 1, at the end of line 13, insert "or leased"AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 1, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following:

"B. Each agency that occupies space greater than ten thousand square feet shall submit to the division of administration by July first of each year and update by January first of each year, the identity of any and all office space in state owned or leased buildings by location and square footage and the identity of any unoccupied or underutilized office space in state owned or leased buildings by location and square footage."

AMENDMENT NO. 5On page 1, at the beginning of line 15, change "B." to "C."AMENDMENT NO. 6On page 1, line 17, after "updated" change "monthly," to "semi-annually,"AMENDMENT NO. 7On page 1, delete line 18 in its entirety and insert "or leased buildings by location and square footage."AMENDMENT NO. 8

Delete page 2 in its entirety and insert the following:

"(2) Identify all available office space that the division of administration determines is suitable for the needs of an agency with leased space, and within thirty days after the semi-annual update of the list required in this Section, send a notice to the head of the agency of the available space.

D.(1) Within ninety days of the notification provided in this Section, the agency head shall respond to the notice with a transitional plan for moving into the available space or a detailed indication of why the space is not suitable for use by the agency.

(2) If the agency does not submit a transitional plan for moving into the space identified or does not move in the time indicated in the plan, the notice to the

1 agency and the agency's response required by this Section shall be submitted to the
2 Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget for consideration at its next meeting. The
3 notices to the agencies and the agencies' responses shall be compiled and included
4 in a report by the division of administration to the Joint Legislative Committee on
5 the Budget on or before March first of each year."

7 On page 3, at the beginning of line 1, change "D." to "E."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 10

9 On page 3, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:

10 "F. The division of administration shall comply with federal laws and
11 regulations and with state-federal agreements with respect to the housing of any
12 agency, or its personnel, operations, equipment, or activities, which receives or
13 administers any federal funds."

15 On page 3, at the beginning of line 7, change "E." to "G."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 12

17 On page 3, line 9, after "R.S." change "27:127(C)" to "39:127(C)"

20 On page 3, between lines 11 and 12, insert the following:

21 "(3) "Lease" means any agreement, including but not limited to cooperative
22 endeavor agreements, professional services contracts, and consulting services
23 contracts which gives rise to relationships of landlord and tenant or lessor and
24 lessee."
