PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST: Limits the amount required to be spent per project under the Percent for Art Program

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 25:900.1(C), relative to the Percent for Art Program; to limit the
3 maximum amount of state money per project to be spent under the program; and to
4 provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 25:900.1(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §900.1. Percent for Art program; established; implementation

8 * * *

9 C. Except as otherwise provided in this Section, whenever more than two
10 million dollars of state funds, whether obtained from the sale of bonds or otherwise,
11 is to be spent by a state agency for the construction or renovation of a state building,
12 the agency that contracts for the construction or renovation shall expend the lesser
13 of one hundred thousand dollars or one percent of the state money to be expended
14 for the project to acquire, conserve, or restore and install works of art for display in,
15 on, or on the grounds of the state building. The one hundred thousand dollar
16 maximum shall apply to all projects begun on or after August 1, 2016. No new
17 contracts shall be entered into after October 1, 2016, to acquire, conserve, restore,
18 or install works of art under this Section for existing projects if such contract would
19 increase the total expenditure for art for such project under the Percent for Art
20 program to exceed one hundred thousand dollars. The work or works of art for the

1 project shall be chosen as provided in Subsection E of this Section. In the case of a
 2 renovation of a state building, the required expenditure or a portion thereof may be
 3 for restoration or conservation of an existing work of art associated with the state
 4 building which is to be renovated.

Abstract: Limits the amount of state dollars to be spent under the Percent for Art Program per construction or renovation project to the lesser of \$100,000 or 1% of the state money to be expended on the project.

Present law, the Percent for Art Program, requires state agencies to dedicate 1% of state funds for construction or renovation project costs to acquire, conserve, or restore and install works of art. Applies only to projects with state funding costs of \$2 million or more.

Proposed law caps the amount of state funds per project dedicated to works of art to the lesser of \$100,000 or 1% of the state money to be expended on the construction or renovation project.

Proposed law applies to all projects begun on or after August 1, 2016, and contracts entered into after October 1, 2016, for existing projects if the contract would increase the total expenditure for art for the project to exceed \$100,000.
