FIRE PROTECT/FIREMEN: Provides relative to the salaries of firemen in the city of Crowley

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:1993(B), relative to the salaries of firemen in the city of
3 Crowley; to provide relative to pay periods for such firemen; and to provide for
4 related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 33:1993(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

10 §1993. Payment of salaries; city of Lafayette and the Fire Protection District
11 Number One of the parish of Ouachita; city of Crowley and city of Baton
12 Rouge and fire protection districts within the parish of East Baton Rouge

13 * * *

14 B. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 33:1992, the governing authority
15 of the city of Crowley and the city of Baton Rouge and of any fire protection district
16 located wholly within the parish of East Baton Rouge may pay the salaries of
17 firemen employed by such governing authority on a biweekly basis.

Abstract: Authorizes the governing authority of the city of Crowley to pay the salary of its firemen on a biweekly basis.

Present law provides that the minimum monthly salaries of firemen in municipalities with a population of 12,000 and in the city of Bastrop and of all parish and fire protection district firemen shall be in accordance with a schedule and shall be paid semi-monthly no later than the fifth and twentieth day of each calendar month.

Present law authorizes the city of Lafayette, the Fire Protection District Number One of the parish of Ouachita, the city of Baton Rouge, and any fire protection district in East Baton Rouge Parish to pay the salaries of firemen on a biweekly basis.

Proposed law retains present law and authorizes the governing authority of the city of Crowley to pay the salaries of its firemen on biweekly basis.
