Provides for recognition of waiver services granted to military parents transferred to Louisiana. (8/1/16)

Proposed law provides that any active duty member of the armed forces who has been assigned to work in Louisiana and has a child that was receiving home and community based waiver services in their state of deployment immediately before coming to Louisiana shall be eligible to receive the next available slot for waiver services upon establishing residency in Louisiana and being determined eligible for Medicaid coverage in Louisiana.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Children of active duty military transferred into Louisiana (and that had a child that was previously receiving home and community based waiver services in their state prior to the transfer) will be offered first priority for the next available slot for Home and Community Based Waiver services. The bill does not authorize the Department of Health and Hospitals to expand waiver services. Waiver services include the New Opportunities Waiver (NOW), Children’s Choice Waiver, Residential Options Waiver, and Supports Waiver.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
