Zeringue

Abstract: Creates the "K9s4COPS" special prestige license plate. Provides for fees, distribution of fees, issuance, creation, and design of the license plate and promulgation of rules.

Proposed law requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to issue special prestige license plates to be known as the "K9s4COPS" license plate.

Proposed law provides for the secretary to work in conjunction with the executive director of K9s4COPS to select the color and design of the plate.

Proposed law specifies that the license plate be issued, upon application, to any citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

Proposed law requires the department to collect an annual royalty fee of \$25 for each plate issued and specifies that such fees be collected by the department and forwarded to K9s4COPS. Specifies that the monies received from the royalty fees shall be used to place fully trained canines in law enforcement agencies and schools in the state of Louisiana.

Proposed law requires the department to collect a handling fee of \$3.50 for each plate, to be retained by the department to offset a portion of the administrative costs.

Proposed law requires the secretary to adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions provided in proposed law.
