SB 335 Reengrossed DIGEST Claitor  
2016 Regular Session

Proposed law prohibits public schools, including charter schools, from requiring the parent or legal guardian of a student to disclose medical information or special education needs prior to enrolling the student, unless otherwise specifically required by law. Allows public schools to provide an enrollment preference to a student with special needs when the student's parent or legal guardian voluntarily provides the school with such information.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the original bill

1. Makes technical changes.
2. Makes provisions of proposed law applicable to all public schools.
3. Allows parents to voluntarily submit student information and schools to provide enrollment preferences using that information.
