AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 16:51(A)(9), relative to assistant district attorneys; to provide for additional district attorneys in the Ninth Judicial District; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 16:51(A)(9) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§51. Assistant district attorneys

A. The district attorney of each judicial district and of the parish of Orleans shall appoint a first assistant district attorney and such other assistant district attorneys for his respective judicial district or for the parish of Orleans as may be necessary, the total number of assistant district attorneys in each judicial district and in the parish of Orleans to be not less than as hereinafter set forth:

(9) In the Ninth Judicial District, ~~fifteen~~ **seventeen** assistant district attorneys;

Present law provides that the district attorney of each judicial district shall appoint a first assistant district attorney and other assistant district attorneys as necessary provided the number of assistant district attorneys is not less than the number stated in present law.

Present law provides that in the Ninth Judicial District there shall be 15 assistant district attorneys.

Proposed law increases the number of assistant district attorneys in the Ninth Judicial District to 17.

Effective August 1, 2016.
