10	D. Parochial and municipal elections in a parish containing a municipality
11	with a population of three hundred thousand or more. Elections for parochial and
12	municipal officers in a parish containing a municipality with a population of three
13	hundred thousand or more shall be held every four years, beginning in 2017 2021,
