
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill No. 441 by Representative Jackson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, delete "conditions for"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, at the beginning of line 4, insert "to provide conditions for terminating
5 participation;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 7, after "Physician" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof
8 "participation; conditions for termination"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 10 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

11 "A. With respect to credentialing of a physician whose license is in
12 probationary status pursuant to action by the Louisiana State Board of Medical
13 Examiners, no managed care organization shall terminate participation by that
14 physician in the organization's provider network based solely upon the probationary
15 status of his license or disqualify the physician from initial credentialing based solely
16 upon the probationary status of his license.

17 B. No managed care organization shall terminate participation by a physician
18 in the organization's provider network unless such action is taken pursuant to an
19 established peer review process or credentialing committee procedure."
