SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 50

COMMENDATIONS. Commends Chancellor Robert A. Barish, MD, for his extraordinary leadership at the LSU Health Science Center in Shreveport and for improvements in health care opportunities in the state of Louisiana.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1 2 To commend Robert A. Barish, MD, Chancellor of Louisiana State University Health Science Center in Shreveport, for extraordinary leadership which has resulted in 3 improved academic accreditation and increased health care services for the populous 4 5 of North Louisiana and the state at-large. 6 WHEREAS, LSU Health Sciences Center Shreveport is an integrated network of 7 academic medical training composed of the School of Medicine, the School of Graduate 8 Studies, and the School of Allied Health Professions, along with E. A. Conway Medical 9 Center in Monroe and Huey P. Long Medical Center in Pineville that collectively facilitate 10 one-half million patient visits annually; and 11 WHEREAS, before Dr. Robert A. Barish began his service in 2009 as chancellor and dean, following Dr. John C. McDonald, he had amassed an inordinate background of 12 13 knowledge and experience in the field of medicine; and 14 WHEREAS, Dr. Barish is a biomedical innovator with a superb work ethic who possesses a fearless sense of adventure, an appetite for new professional challenges, and the 15 insight to create clinical efficiency in complex medical infrastructures; and 16 17 WHEREAS, as an emergency medicine intern, Dr. Barish joined the International 18 Rescue Committee, founded by the late Dr. Albert Schweitzer, to provide assistance to

1 rudimentary clinical facilities in Cambodia, Somalia, and Kuwait; and WHEREAS, returning to the United States, Dr. Barish completed his residencies in 2 3 internal medicine at St. Vincent Hospital in New York City and in the newly-emerging 4 specialty of emergency medicine at Georgetown University School of Medicine in Washington, D.C., and he obtained an advanced MBA degree from Loyola University-5 6 Maryland; and 7 WHEREAS, he was the youngest person appointed chief of hospital emergency 8 services at the University of Maryland School of Medicine where he served for twenty-four 9 years; that program evolved into one of the largest programs of its kind in the nation; and 10 WHEREAS, Dr. Barish also enlisted in the Maryland Air National Guard, became 11 a flight surgeon in aerospace medicine, and became a candidate in the astronaut program at 12 NASA; and 13 WHEREAS, as chancellor, Dr. Barish accelerated growth by implementation of the 14 Vision 2020 strategic plan and, through its development, enrollment increased by 15 twenty-five percent and in 2014 and 2015, applications for admittance exceeded all previous 16 school records; and WHEREAS, Dr. Barish and his leadership team achieved a decade of reaffirmations 17 18 with commendations for leadership, operational effectiveness, and contributions to the 19 regional workforce from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools; and 20 WHEREAS, during his tenure the institution achieved full accreditation from the 21 Liaison Committee on Medical Education, the Residency Review Committee, the Association for Accreditation of Human Research Participant Protection Programs, as well 22 23 as a five-year approval rating from the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical 24 Education; and 25 WHEREAS, recognizing the importance of a skilled faculty in preparing future health care professionals and improving the availability of quality health care to North 26 27 Louisiana and the state, Dr. Barish successfully recruited more than thirty exceptional physicians and specialists, earning him the reputation of "most valuable recruiter"; and 28 29 WHEREAS, Dr. Barish holds prestigious affiliations and fellowships with Alpha

Omega Alpha Medical Honor Society, the American College of Emergency Physicians, and

1	the American Academy of Emergency Medicine; and
2	WHEREAS, Dr. Barish took patient care into the community through Barbers for
3	Blood Pressure Awareness and mobile 3-D mammography screening; and
4	WHEREAS, he further developed community awareness of life-saving techniques
5	through events such as "An Evening For Heroes", a program that highlights the expertise of
6	911 operators and trauma surgeons; and
7	WHEREAS, Dr. Barish serves the community through participation in organizations
8	such as The Strand Theatre, Committee of 100, the Barksdale Global Power Museum, the
9	Military Affairs Council, and Boy Scouts of America, Inc. to name a few; and
10	WHEREAS, the state of Louisiana owes Dr. Barish a debt of gratitude for his
11	humanitarian efforts as a volunteer physician who brought much-needed medical treatment
12	to Jefferson Parish in the chaotic aftermath of Hurricane Katrina; and
13	WHEREAS, Robert Barish shares his wonderful life with his wife, Jenny, and their
14	daughters, Dani B. Blevins, Liza, and Sophie; Liza continues the family tradition in her final
15	year of medical school; and
16	WHEREAS, as Dr. Robert Barish now enters a new phase in his phenomenal career,
17	as vice chancellor for health affairs at University of Illinois at Chicago, he is appreciated as
18	a renaissance man of many skills and talents; for his mentorship that has advanced others in
19	his profession; and for his leadership that has elevated LSU Health Sciences Center
20	Shreveport to a higher realm in the national hierarchy of academia, clinical care, and
21	research.
22	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
23	commend Robert A. Barish, MD, Chancellor of Louisiana State University Health Science
24	Center in Shreveport, for extraordinary leadership in the advancement of the institution and
25	for the rich legacy of medical instruction and research that he leaves to the state.
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby extend
27	its best wishes to Dr. Robert Barish for success in all future endeavors.
