6 obtain" and insert "for"7 AMENDMENT NO. 38 On page 3, line 2, after "such person" and before "as a condition" insert "to be obtained"9 AMENDMENT NO. 410 On page 3, after line 18, delete the remainder of the page and on page 4 delete lines 1 and  
11 2 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:12 "D. ~~Upon request by the board, the bureau shall conduct a search of its~~  
13 ~~criminal history record information relative to the applicant and report the results of~~  
14 ~~its search to the board within sixty days after receipt of any such request. Upon~~  
15 receiving fingerprints, the bureau shall survey its criminal history records and  
16 identification files and make a simultaneous request of the FBI for like information  
17 from other jurisdictions. The bureau shall provide a report promptly and in writing,  
18 but shall provide only such information as is necessary to specify whether or not the  
19 person has been arrested for or convicted of or pled nolo contendere to any crime or  
20 crimes, the crime or crimes of which he has been arrested for or convicted or to  
21 which he has pled nolo contendere, and the date or dates on which they occurred.  
22 The report provided pursuant to the provisions of this Subsection shall include  
23 arrests, convictions, or other dispositions, including any conviction dismissed  
24 pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Article 893 or 894. The bureau may charge  
25 the board a reasonable processing fee for conducting and reporting on any such  
26 search."
