Proposed law authorizes the governing authority of each public school to require that at least one member of the coaching staff of each extracurricular sport offered by the school be certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), first aid, and the use of an automated external defibrillator (AED).

(Adds R.S. 17:81(AA))

### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill:

1. Instead of requiring public school governing authorities to ensure that at least two members of the coaching staff for each sport are CPR-certified, authorize them to require that at least one member of such staff have such certification.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Add first aid and AED use to the certifications that public school governing authorities may require for at least one member of each sport's coaching staff.
