WHEREAS, as head coach, Donald Shows led the West Monroe Rebels to win two national championships in 1998 and 2000; and

WHEREAS, under his leadership, the Rebels also won seven state championships, seventeen straight district titles, and maintained undefeated records in 1997, 1998, 2000, and 2009, among other awards and achievements; and

WHEREAS, Coach Shows was named All-Northeastern Coach of the Year in 1996, 2004, and 2008, and Class 5A Coach of the Year in 2011, and was inducted into the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame in 2011; and

WHEREAS, his legacy will long be remembered by the countless players he inspired on and off the field and by the many people who knew and loved him.
