Subject: Relative to psychiatric inpatient and crisis stabilization beds

 Requires all private and public facilities to report psychiatric inpatient and crisis stabilization beds at least once daily.

Proposed law requires DHH to develop and administer a web-based acute psychiatric bed registry to collect, aggregate, and display information about available acute beds in public and private inpatient psychiatric treatment facilities and public and private crisis receiving centers to assist with the identification and designation of facilities for the temporary detention and treatment of individuals who meet the criteria for admission by emergency certificate or an order for protective custody. Proposed law requires the registry to be a searchable database that includes descriptive information and real-time information on the availability and type of beds for every public and private inpatient psychiatric treatment facility and every public and private crisis receiving center in the state. Proposed law requires these facilities and centers licensed by DHH to designate employees to submit information to the registry and to update information as availability changes or at least daily. Proposed law requires DHH to work with the division of administration and the office of technology services to determine whether existing software technology and data systems is sufficient to meet the requirements of the registry. Proposed law authorizes DHH to enter into a contract with private entity for the development and administration of the registry.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

All hospitals and nursing homes are currently required to electronically report monthly their available and staffed bed count to DHH. This measure requires the department to take this collected data and develop a web-based acute psychiatric bed registry that will have to be able to display and report this information in real-time. The department anticipates a nominal one-time cost (\$1,000) to pay the vendor that owns the software to modify this system in order to comply with the requirement. It is anticipated these costs to be covered with existing staff and resources.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
