The appointing authority shall discharge from the service any employee 23 whom he deems guilty of violating any one or more of the provisions of this Section 24 conduct an investigation of any person alleged to have violated a provision of 25 this Section, unless a request by the appointing authority is made to the board 26 to conduct such an investigation. If as a result of such investigation the 27 employee is determined to be guilty of violating one or more provisions of this 28 Section, he shall be suspended for thirty work days without pay for a first 29 violation or discharged for a second violation. However, any employee found 30 to have violated Paragraph (A)(4)(c) of this Section shall be terminated upon the determination of a violation of the offense. The board may, upon its own initiative, 31 32 or upon the request of the appointing authority, investigate any officer or 33 employee in the classified service whom it reasonably believes guilty of violating any one or more of the provisions. Any citizen, taxpayer, municipal officer, or 34 35 employee may file with the board detailed charges in writing against any employee 36 in the classified service for violating any one or more of the provisions of this 37 Section. The board shall, within thirty days after receiving the written charges, hold a public hearing and investigation and determine whether such charges are true and 38 39 correct. If the board should find upon its investigation of any employee that he has 40 violated any of the foregoing provisions of this Section, the board shall order the 41 appointing authority to forthwith suspend the employee without pay for thirty work days for a first violation and mandate educational training on prohibited political activities. If the board determines an employee has violated any of the provisions of this Section for a second time, the board shall order the discharge the guilty of the employee from the service and the appointing authority shall forthwith discharge the employee.

C. Whoever violates is found to have violated a provision of this Section <u>twice</u> shall be subject to the penalties provided in R.S. 33:2507. In addition any employee in the classified service who is discharged because of violating a foregoing provision <u>of this Section</u> shall not again be eligible for employment or public office in the classified service for a period of six years from the time of his discharge."

If the board should find upon 31 its investigation of any employee that he has violated any of the foregoing provisions 32 of this Section, the board shall order the appointing authority to forthwith suspend 33 the employee without pay for thirty work days for a first violation and mandate 34 educational training on prohibited political activities. If the board determines 35 an employee has violated any of the provisions of this Section for a second time, 36 the board shall order the discharge the guilty of the employee from the service and 37 the appointing authority shall forthwith discharge the employee. 38 C. Whoever violates is found to have violated this Part twice shall be

subject to the penalties provided in R.S. 33:2567. In addition any employee in the
classified service who is discharged because of violating a foregoing provision of
this Section shall not again be eligible for employment or public office in the
classified service for a period of six years from the time of his discharge."
