COMMENDATIONS. Commends Anna Li upon receiving a Bradley-Alavi Student Fellowship from the Society of Nuclear Medicine and Molecular Imaging.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend and congratulate Anna Li upon being awarded a Bradley-Alavi Student
3 Fellowship.

4 WHEREAS, the Bradley-Alavi Student Fellowship is awarded to students who
5 demonstrate outstanding competence in nuclear medicine research; and

6 WHEREAS, as a third-year medical student, the current president of the Academic
7 Medicine Club and Interventional Radiology Interest Group, and vice-president of the
8 Radiology Interest Group, Anna Li has been active in research with the Department of
9 Radiology since her first year of medical school; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Li's initial project, "Percutaneous biliary drainage catheters fluid
11 dynamics: in vitro flow rates and patterns," was under the mentorship of Dr. Horacio
12 D'Agostino, Chair of Radiology, and produced a scientific paper presentation at the
13 Radiological Society of North America's Annual Meeting in November 2015; and

14 WHEREAS, in the last year, Ms. Li has been engaged in several nuclear medicine
15 research projects under the guidance of Dr. Zhiyun Yang, Director of Nuclear Medicine; and

16 WHEREAS, in January, Ms. Li gave oral and poster presentations at the Louisiana
17 State Medical Society's Research Symposium, placing third in the poster contest; and

18 WHEREAS, with the generous support from the Society of Nuclear Medicine and

1 Molecular Imaging's Bradley-Alavi Student Fellowship, Ms. Li will continue her research
2 under the mentorship of Dr. Yang, with Dr. D'Agostino and Dr. Alberto Simoncini as
3 co-advisors; and

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Li will be investigating correlations between patient-reported
5 anatomical sites of pain, radiographic findings of bone formation, and uptake pattern and
6 intensity on bone single-photon emission computed tomography/computed tomography
7 (SPECT/CT) in patients with pain after hip or knee arthroplasty in her project titled
8 "Correlation of bone SPECT/CT and radiography with clinical findings in painful hip and
9 knee prostheses;" and

10 WHEREAS, the Fellowship will culminate in publication of a report in the Education
11 and Research Foundation for Nuclear Medicine and Molecular Imaging's Annual Report in
12 2017 and provide a monetary award of \$3,000 for a three-month period.

13 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
14 does hereby commend and congratulate Ms. Anna Li upon being chosen as a recipient of the
15 Bradley-Alavi Student Fellowship, and does hereby extend to her heartfelt wishes for
16 continued success in her future endeavors.
