## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, line 16, after "<u>student in</u>" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu
thereof "any nurse training course, to provide a full set of fingerprints,"

## 8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 3, after line 18, delete the remainder of the page and on page 4 delete lines 1 and 10 2 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

11 "D. Upon request by the board, the bureau shall conduct a search of its criminal history record information relative to the applicant and report the results of 12 13 its search to the board within sixty days after receipt of any such request. Upon 14 receiving fingerprints, the bureau shall survey its criminal history records and 15 identification files and make a simultaneous request of the FBI for like information 16 from other jurisdictions. The bureau shall provide a report promptly and in writing, 17 but shall provide only such information as is necessary to specify whether or not the person has been arrested for or convicted of or pled nolo contendere to any crime or 18 19 crimes, the crime or crimes of which he has been arrested for or convicted or to 20 which he has pled nolo contendere, and the date or dates on which they occurred. 21 The report provided pursuant to the provisions of this Subsection shall include arrests, convictions, or other dispositions, including any conviction dismissed 22 23 pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Article 893 or 894. The bureau may charge 24 the board a reasonable processing fee for conducting and reporting on any such 25 search."
