



1           WHEREAS, for the foregoing reasons, continuation of this study committee's efforts  
2 is a priority of the legislature.

3           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
4 continue the study committee to evaluate Louisiana's statewide system of healthcare delivery  
5 created by House Concurrent Resolution No. 170 of the 2015 Regular Session.

6           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that legislative authority for the study committee  
7 shall continue through December 31, 2017.

8           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the purposes of the study committee shall  
9 continue as provided in House Concurrent Resolution No. 170 of the 2015 Regular Session.

10          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the membership of the study committee shall  
11 continue as provided in House Concurrent Resolution No. 170 of the 2015 Regular Session  
12 with the addition of the chief executive officer of the Louisiana Ambulance Alliance or his  
13 designee as a committee member.

14          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is hereby authorized to receive  
15 and expend funds, through any member organization selected by the committee to act as a  
16 fiscal agent, as may be necessary to carry out its legislatively provided functions, including  
17 but not limited to funding provided by contract or other agreement with the Department of  
18 Health and Hospitals; funds appropriated by the legislature, including any appropriation of  
19 federal funds; and any public or private donations, gifts, or grants from governmental  
20 sources, individuals, corporations, nonprofit organizations, or other business entities.

21          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
22 chancellor of Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at New Orleans, the  
23 chancellor of Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at Shreveport, the dean of  
24 the Southern University Nelson Mandela School of Public Policy, the secretary of the  
25 Department of Health and Hospitals, the commissioner of insurance, the chief executive  
26 officer of the Louisiana Association of Health Plans, the chief executive officer of the  
27 Louisiana State Medical Society, the president of the Louisiana Academy of Family  
28 Physicians, the executive director of the Louisiana Primary Care Association, the executive  
29 director of the Louisiana State Nurses Association, the president and chief executive officer  
30 of the Louisiana Hospital Association, the executive director of the Rural Hospital Coalition,

1 Inc., the director of Navigators for a Healthy Louisiana, the president of the Louisiana  
2 Center for Health Equity, the director of the Campaign for Healthcare for Everyone -  
3 Louisiana, the executive director of the Advocacy Center, the executive director of the
