FUNDS/FUNDING. Provides for a limitation relative to certain appropriations for hospitals associated with the LSU Health Sciences Center of Shreveport, the LSU Health Sciences Center at New Orleans, and the LSU Health Care Services Division. (7/1/17)

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1519.6(A) and to enact R.S. 17:1517(D)(5) and (6), and
3	1519.1(13), relative to limitations on certain appropriations to the LSU Health
4	Sciences Center at Shreveport, the LSU Health Sciences Center at New Orleans, and
5	the LSU Health Care Services Division; to provide for the responsibility for the
6	monies appropriated for certain legacy costs associated with the privatization of the
7	hospitals that are a part of the LSU Health Sciences Center at Shreveport, and the
8	LSU Health Sciences Center at New Orleans and the LSU Health Care Services
9	Division; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. 17:1519.6(A) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
12	17:1517(D)(5) and (6), and 1519.1(13) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

14	A.(1) The health care services division shall be an organizational unit within
15	the LSU HSC-NO and shall be budgeted as a single appropriation separate and
16	distinct from the appropriation or budget for any other institution or school under the
17	supervision and management of the board. The appropriation for the health care
18	services division shall only indicate only the amount of state general fund dollars
19	appropriated to this schedule and shall exclude state general funds for Medicaid and
20	Medicaid-Uncompensated Care. All other funds generated by hospital operations
21	shall be deposited directly into the Health Care Services Fund without appropriation.
22	Funds from other institutions, schools, or divisions under the management of the
23	board shall not be used to offset any deficit which may occur within the health care
24	services division, and, conversely, funds from the health care services division shall
25	not be used to offset any deficit which may occur within other institutions, schools,

20	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2017; if vetoed by the governor
21	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
22	2017, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to the composition of the LSU Medical School at Shreveport, the LSU Health Sciences Center at Shreveport, the LSU Health Care Services Division, and the Health Sciences Center at New Orleans.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that in any fiscal year that monies are not specifically appropriated for the payment of certain legacy costs of any hospitals that are part of the LSU Health Sciences Center and the Health Care Services Division that have been

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any monies specifically appropriated for the payment of certain legacy costs shall not be used to displace, replace, or supplant appropriations for any other operational costs of the health sciences center.

<u>Proposed law</u> also specifies that in the event of a budget deficit or fiscal emergency during any fiscal year, the appropriations for legacy costs and associated personnel shall not be reduced from the health sciences centers to compensate for the deficit or fiscal emergency.

<u>Proposed law</u> further defines what legacy costs shall include, such as liability and insurance coverage for worker's compensation; medical malpractice and property claims; auditing costs, civil service and training costs; personnel costs such as termination pay, unemployment compensation, and retiree health and life insurance benefits; and other miscellaneous costs, such as utilities, buildings and grounds maintenance, security costs, or administrative costs.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to the original bill

- 1. Provides that any monies specifically appropriated for the payment of legacy costs shall not be used to displace, replace, or supplant appropriations for any other operational costs of the health sciences center.
- 2. Expands the responsibility of the division of administration relative to legacy costs includes the hospitals of the LSU Health Sciences Center in Shreveport, the Health Care Services Division, and the Health Sciences Center in New Orleans.
