Proposed law requires the State Registrar within the Office of Public Health, Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH) to issue a copy birth and death certificates to any member of a law enforcement agency upon written request from said agency.

The proposed legislation requires the State Registrar to issue a copy of birth and death certificates to any member of a law enforcement agency upon written request from said agency. The State Registrar already provides certified copies of death records stamped "law enforcement purpose only" to federal, state and local law enforcement agencies. The department has indicated that providing certified copies of birth records stamped "law enforcement purpose only" will not require additional resources or staff. The LFO does not anticipate the number of requests for birth or death records to increase as a result of this measure.
