1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "R.S. 40:1137.3(E)(2)," and insert in lieu thereof "R.S.
3 40:1137.3(B) and (E)(2),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 3, after "defibrillators;" and before "to require" insert "to repeal a
6 requirement that such entities provide certain notification to the Department of Health and
7 Hospitals;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 4, after "premises;" and before "and to" insert "to provide for enforceability;"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 6, delete "R.S. 40:1137.3(E)(2) is" and insert in lieu thereof "R.S.
12 40:1137.3(B) and (E)(2) are"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:

15 "B. Any person or entity that possesses an AED shall notify ~~the bureau of~~
16 ~~emergency medical services of the Department of Health and Hospitals and~~ a local
17 provider of emergency medical services, such as a 911 service, local ambulance
18 service, or ~~the~~ fire department of the acquisition, location, and type of AED.

20 AMENDMENT NO. 6

21 On page 1, after line 18, insert the following:

22 "Section 3. The provisions of R.S. 40:1137.3(E), as amended by Section 1 of this
23 Act, which require that each high school have an automated external defibrillator on its
24 premises shall become operative and enforceable on January 1, 2018."
