SCHOOLS: Requires high schools to keep automated external defibrillators on their premises

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1137.3(B) and (E)(2), relative to entities in possession of
3 automated external defibrillators; to repeal a requirement that such entities provide
4 certain notification to the Department of Health and Hospitals; to require that each
5 high school have an automated external defibrillator on its premises; to provide for
6 enforceability; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 40:1137.3(B) and (E)(2) are hereby amended and reenacted to read
9 as follows:

10 §1137.3. Persons in possession of AEDs; training, testing, and notification
11 requirements; manufacturer responsibility; possession required

13 B. Any person or entity that possesses an AED shall notify ~~the bureau of~~
14 ~~emergency medical services of the Department of Health and Hospitals~~ and a local
15 provider of emergency medical services, such as a 911 service, local ambulance
16 service, or ~~the~~ fire department of the acquisition, location, and type of AED.

1. Repeal present law requiring any person or entity that possesses an AED to notify the bureau of emergency medical services of the Dept. of Health and Hospitals of the acquisition, location, and type of AED.
2. Provide that proposed law requiring each high school to have an automated external defibrillator on its premises shall become operative and enforceable on January 1, 2018.
