1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 2, delete line 8, and insert the following:
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"C.(1)(a) The recovery district shall retain jurisdiction"

4 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 2</u>

5 On page 2, line 17, after "<u>was transferred</u>." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 6 18 and 19 in their entirety and insert the following:

7 "The superintendent of the local school system, in collaboration with the superintendent of the recovery district, shall develop a plan for the return of the schools. The plan shall be submitted to the local school board for approval by not later than December 31, 2016.
11 (b) Each school transferred to the local school system shall be

(b) Each school transferred to the local school system shall be converted to a Type 3B charter school as provided in R.S. 17:3973(2)(b)(v)(cc)(II). The initial charter contract for each school transferred shall be for a number of years equal to the number of years remaining on the school's Type 5 charter contract at the time of the transfer.

(c)(i) The recovery district shall return all buildings, facilities, and property that are part of the school being returned to the local school system free of any encumbrances, including liens and judgements, other than those financing transactions to which the local school board is a party.

(ii) The local school board shall have no obligation to reimburse the recovery district, the state Department of Education, or the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education for any maintenance, alterations, or other repairs made to any of the school's buildings, facilities, or property before the school's return to the local school system.

(d) The local school board and its individual members shall be immune from civil liability for any damages arising from acts, omissions, or incidents occurring during the time a school returned to the local school system was under the jurisdiction of the recovery district.

(e) The local school board and its individual members shall be
 immune from any liability or responsibility for any obligation, claim,
 demand for reimbursement, or other indebtedness asserted by the Federal
 Emergency Management Agency, the United States Department of Housing
 and Urban Development, or any other federal or state governmental agency
 or entity with respect to construction projects managed by the recovery
 district."
