1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, delete "(D)(1)(a), and (E)(1)(a),"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 12, delete ", (D)(1)(a) and (E)(1)(a)"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, line 5, delete "of the term or terms of imprisonment" and delete "and upon"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 2, line 6, delete "reaching the age of forty-five"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 5

10 On page 2, delete line 7 and insert:

11 "life sentence **for a sex offense or to an offender with a sentence of death**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 2, line 13, change "**their**" to "**his**" and delete "or a sex offense as defined in"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 7

15 On page 2, line 14, delete "R.S. 15:541"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 8

17 On page 2, delete lines 22 through 27 and insert:

18 "(a) The offender has ~~not been convicted of a crime of violence as defined~~
19 ~~in R.S. 14:2(B) or a sex offense as defined in R.S. 15:541, or convicted of an offense~~
20 ~~which would constitute a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2(B) or a sex~~
21 ~~offense as defined in R.S. 15:541, **been convicted a first time of a crime of**~~
22 ~~**violence or convicted a second time of a crime of violence if his first conviction**~~
23 ~~**was not a crime of violence,** regardless of the date of conviction."~~

24 AMENDMENT NO. 9

25 On page 3, delete line 12 and insert:

26 "~~before being eligible for parole~~ **be eligible for parole consideration upon serving**
27 **twenty years in actual custody.** The victim or victim's family shall be notified"

28 AMENDMENT NO. 10

29 On page 3, delete lines 18 through 26 and insert:

30 "(2) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any person serving
31 a life sentence, with or without the benefit of parole, ~~who has not been convicted of~~
